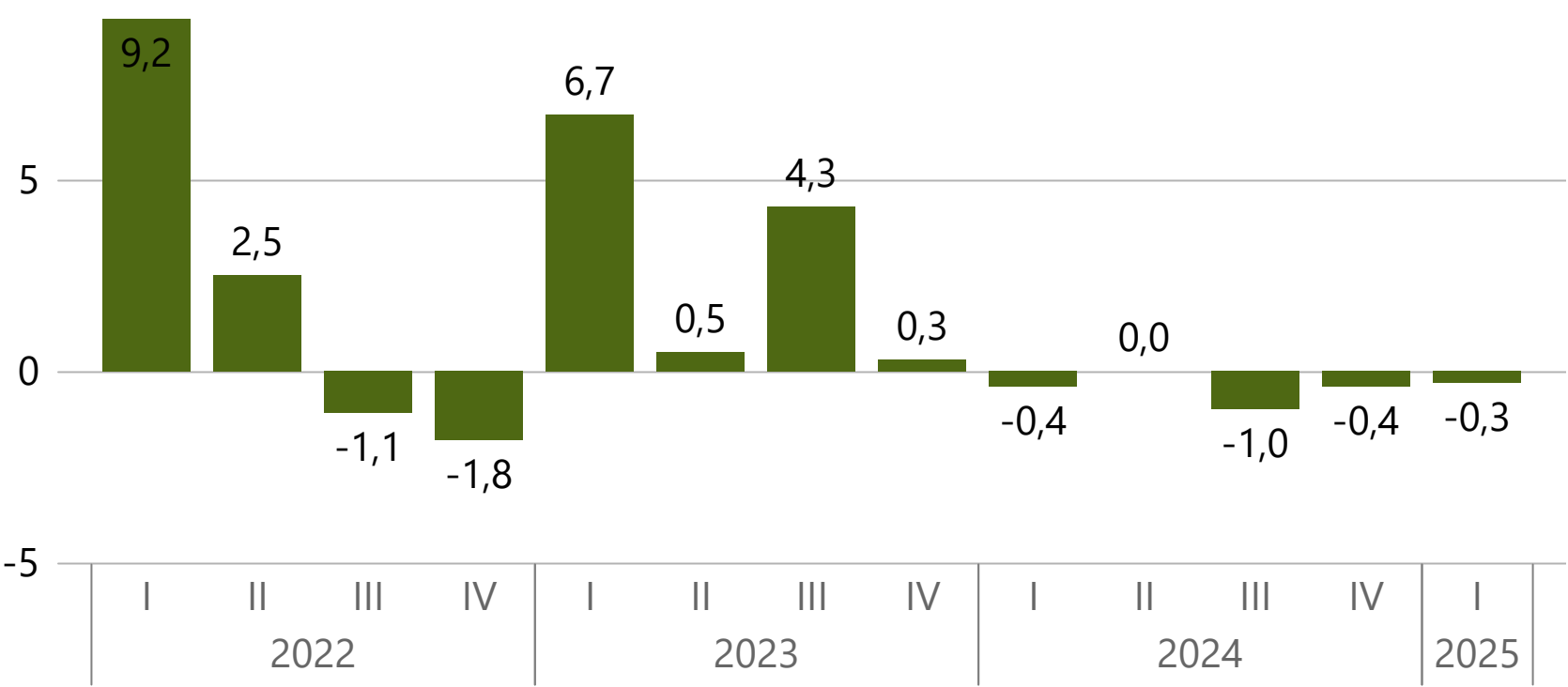

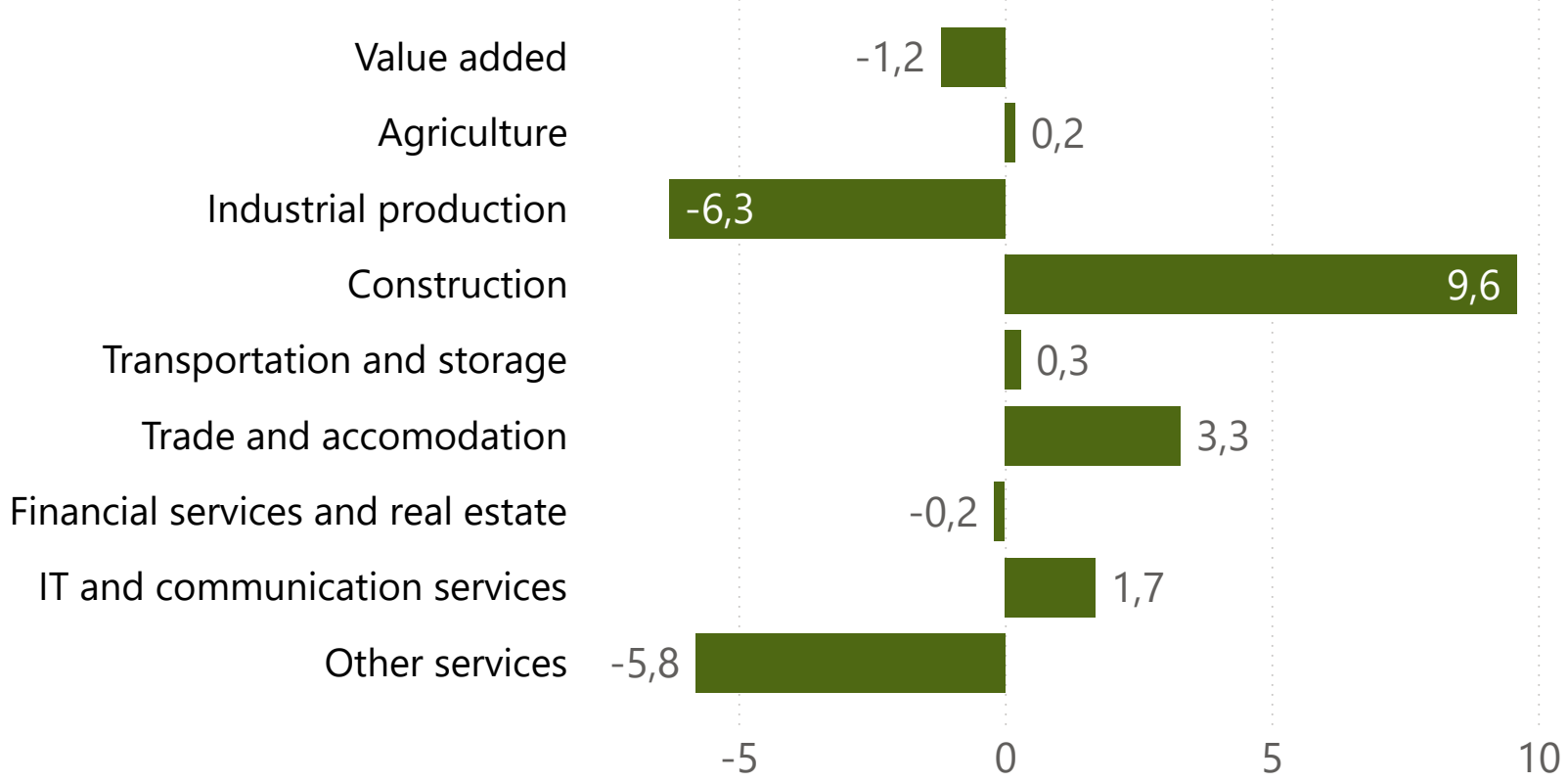

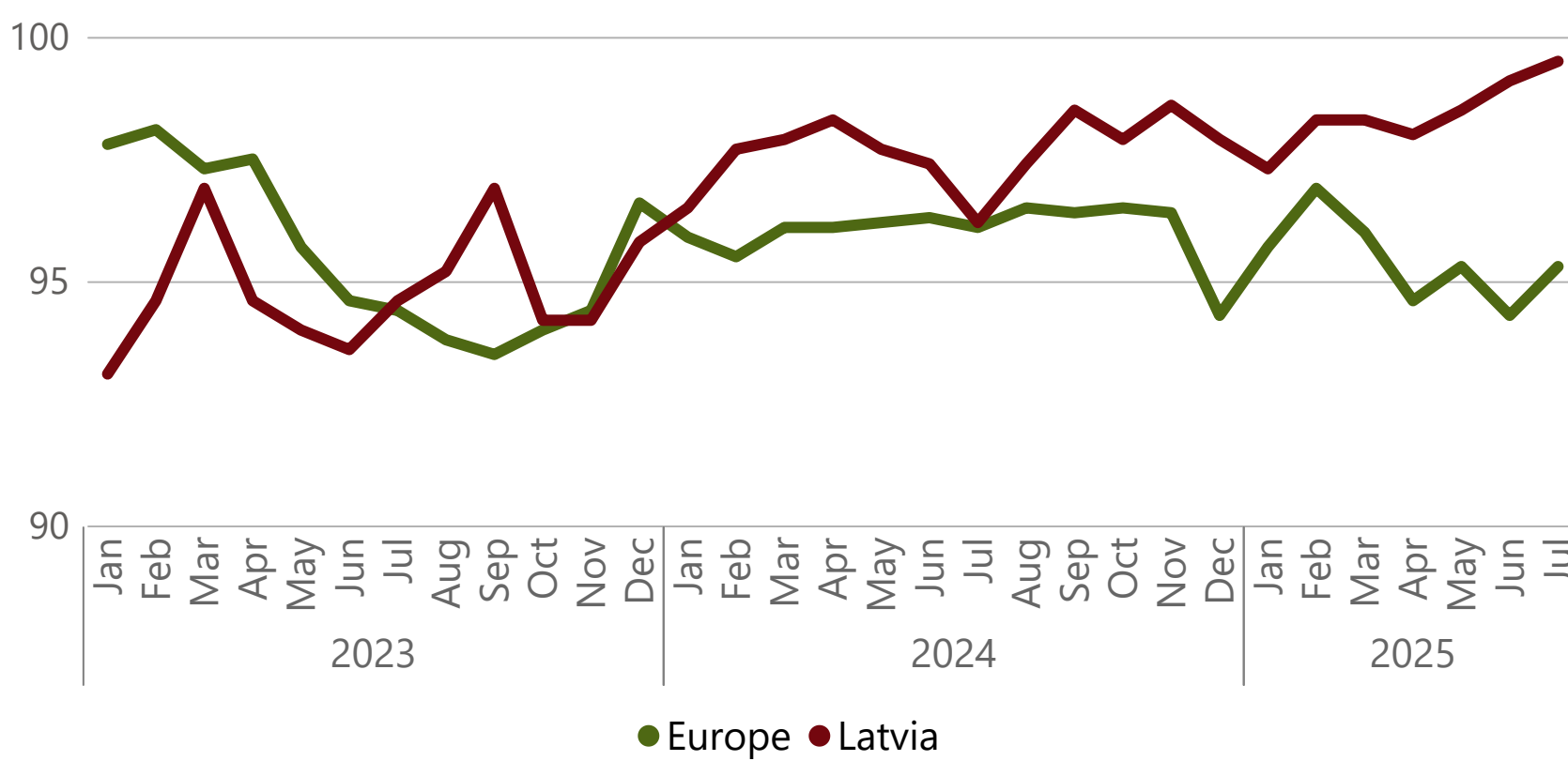
GDP growth, YoY%

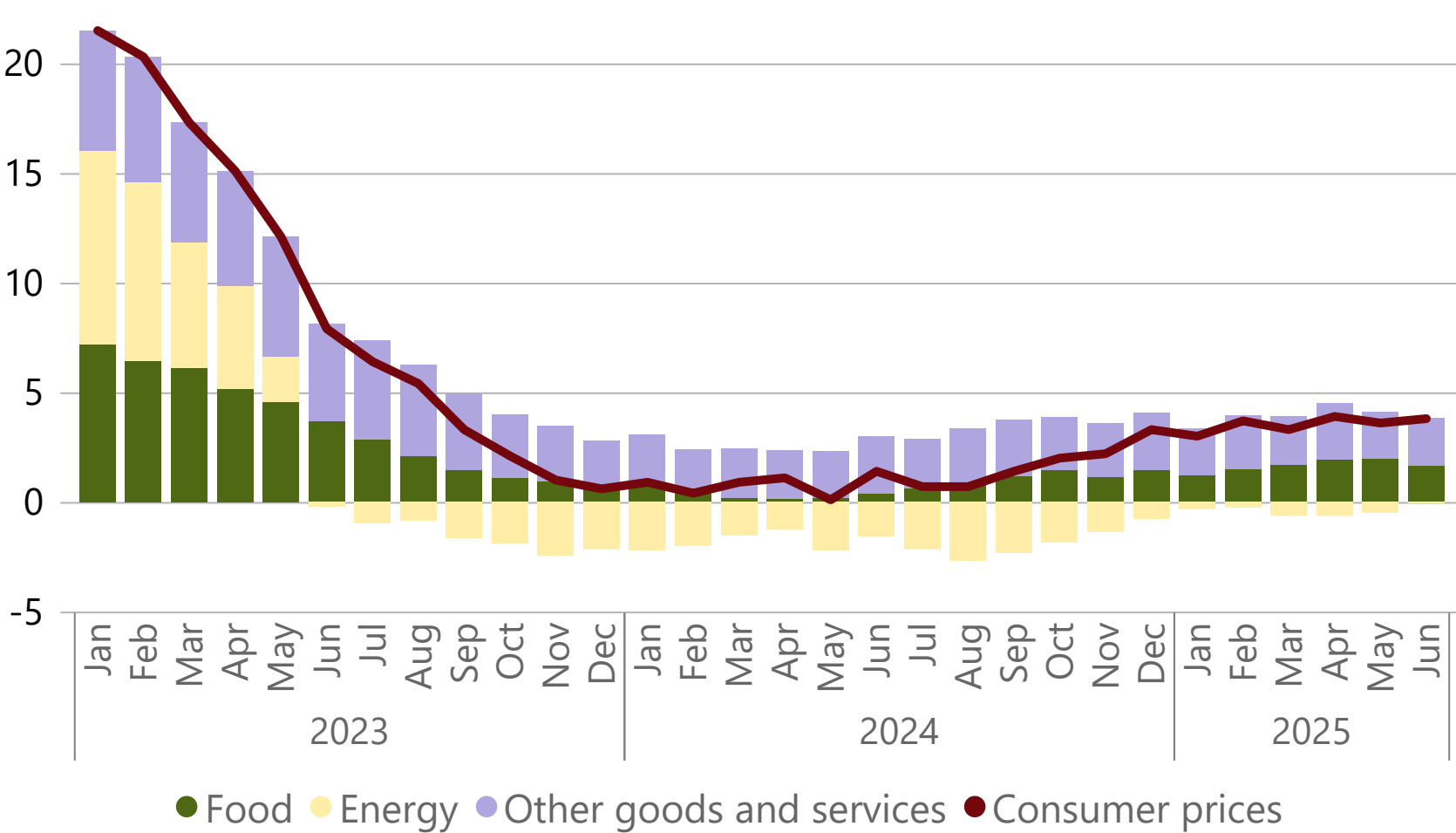

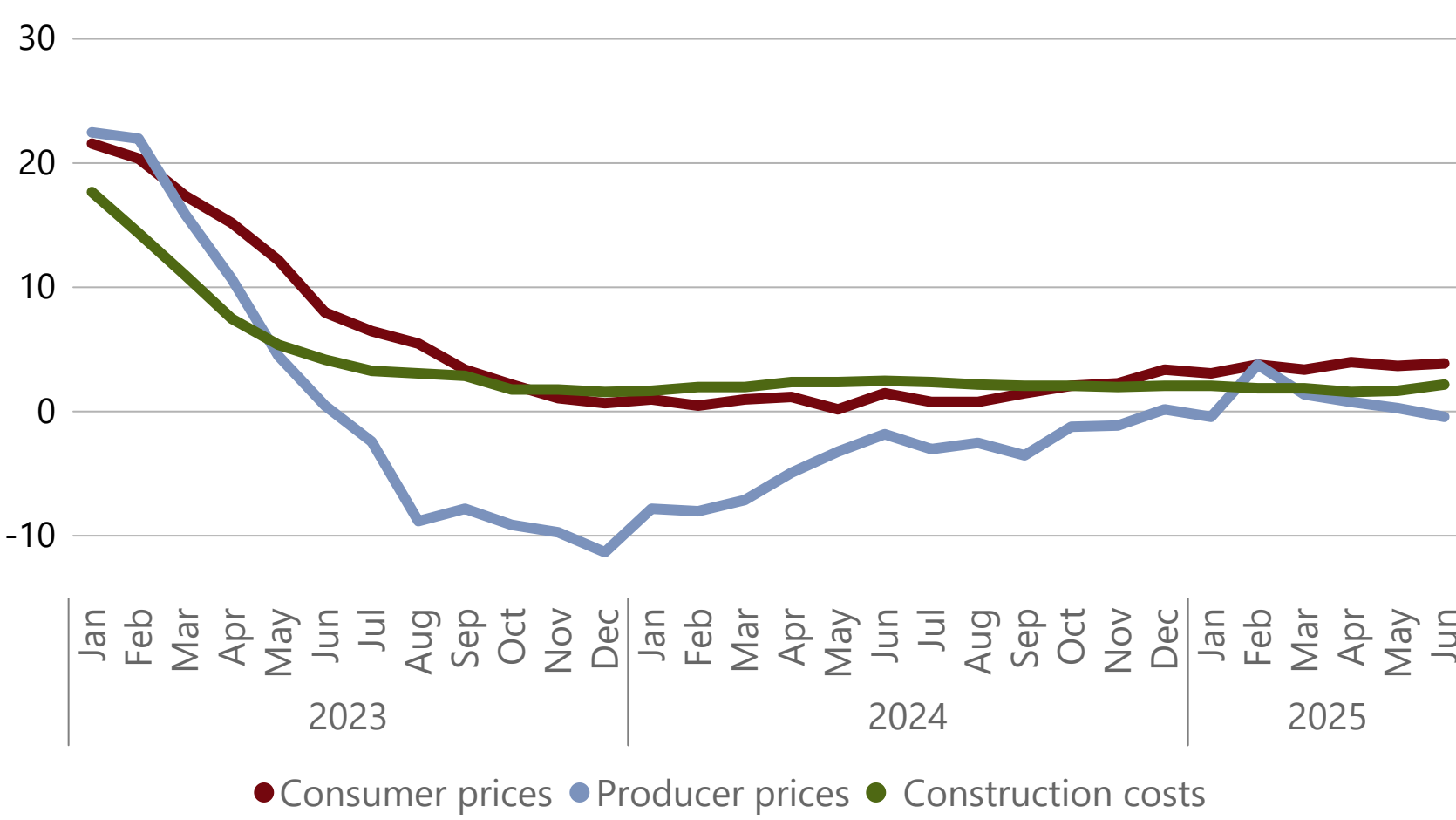

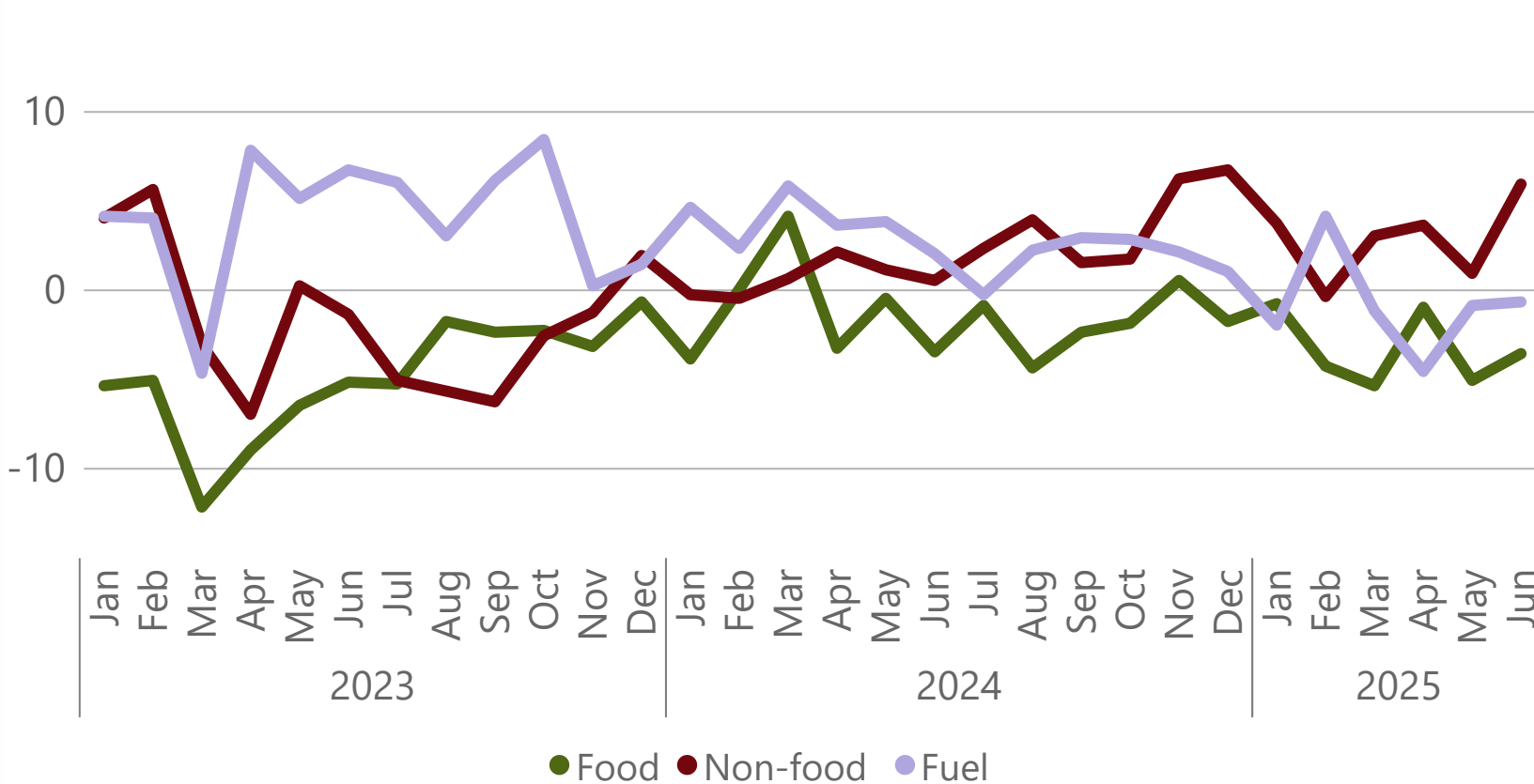

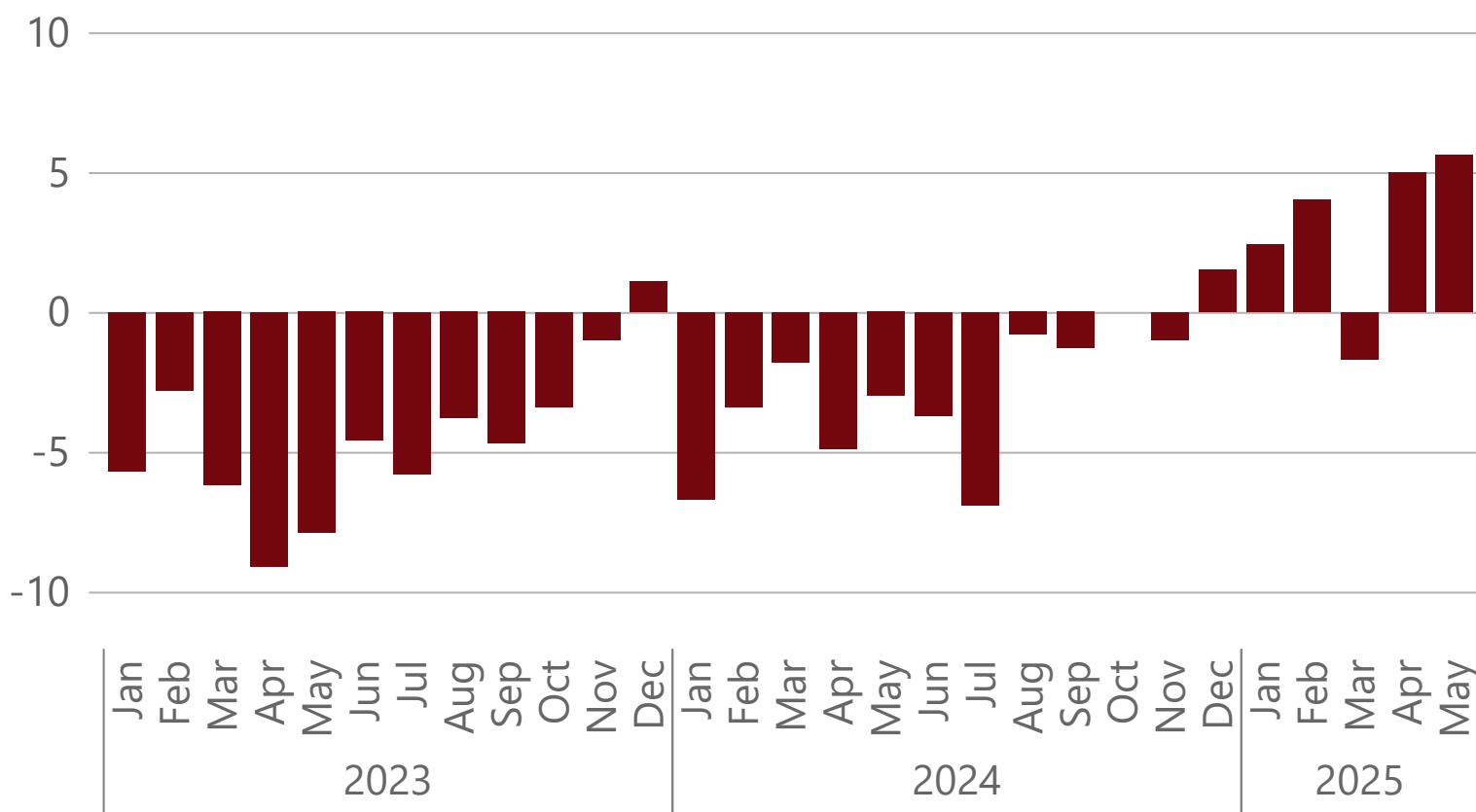

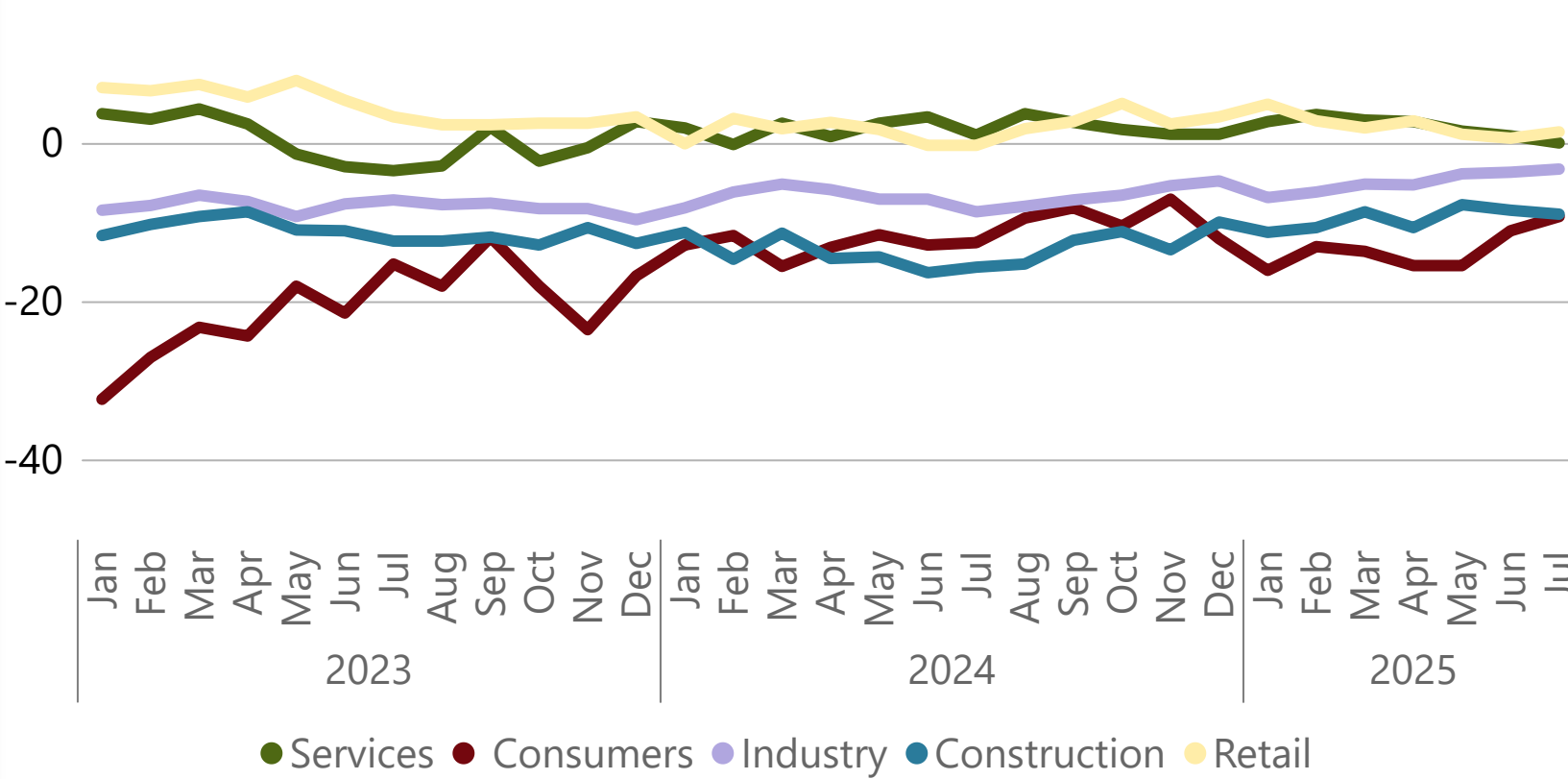
Retail trade growth, YoY%



Manufacturing output, YoY%

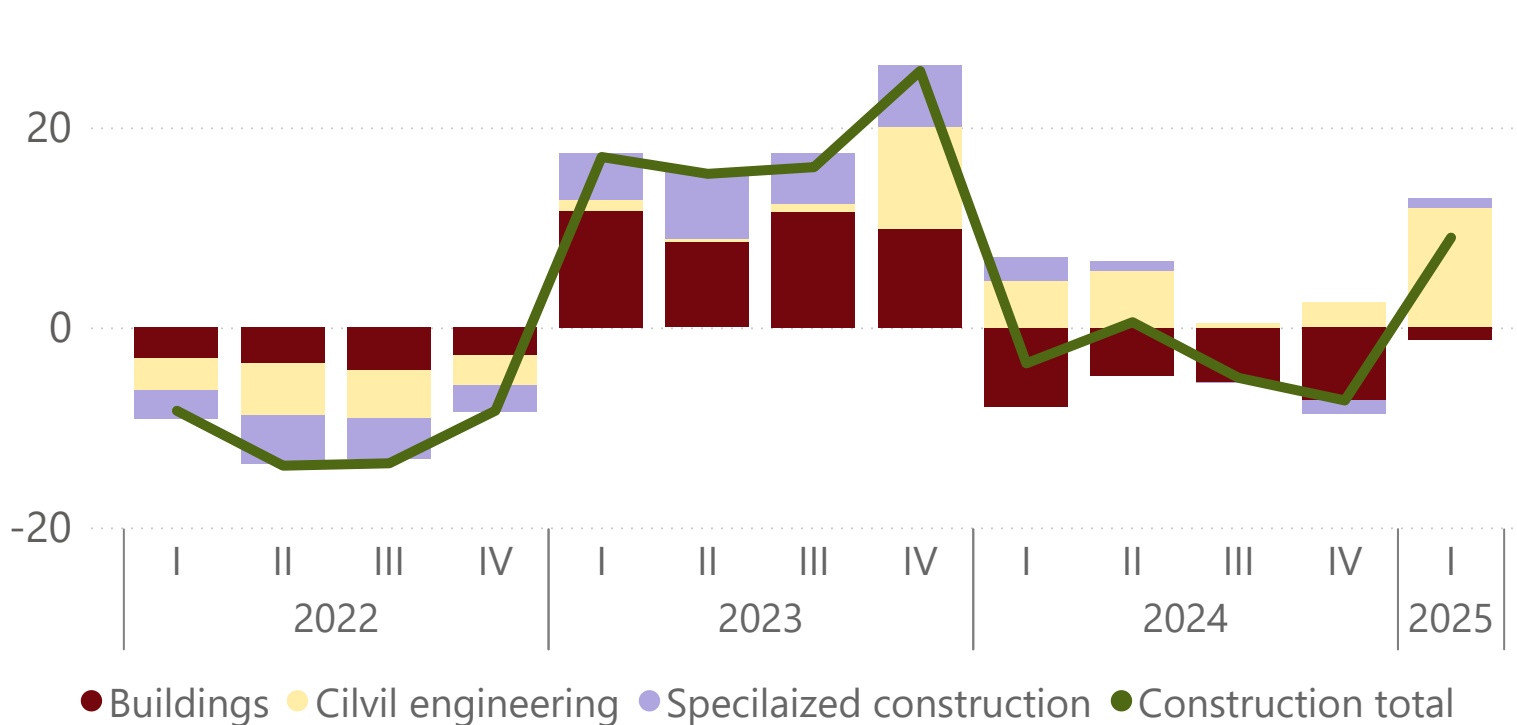


ESI Sector Confidence Index in Latvia

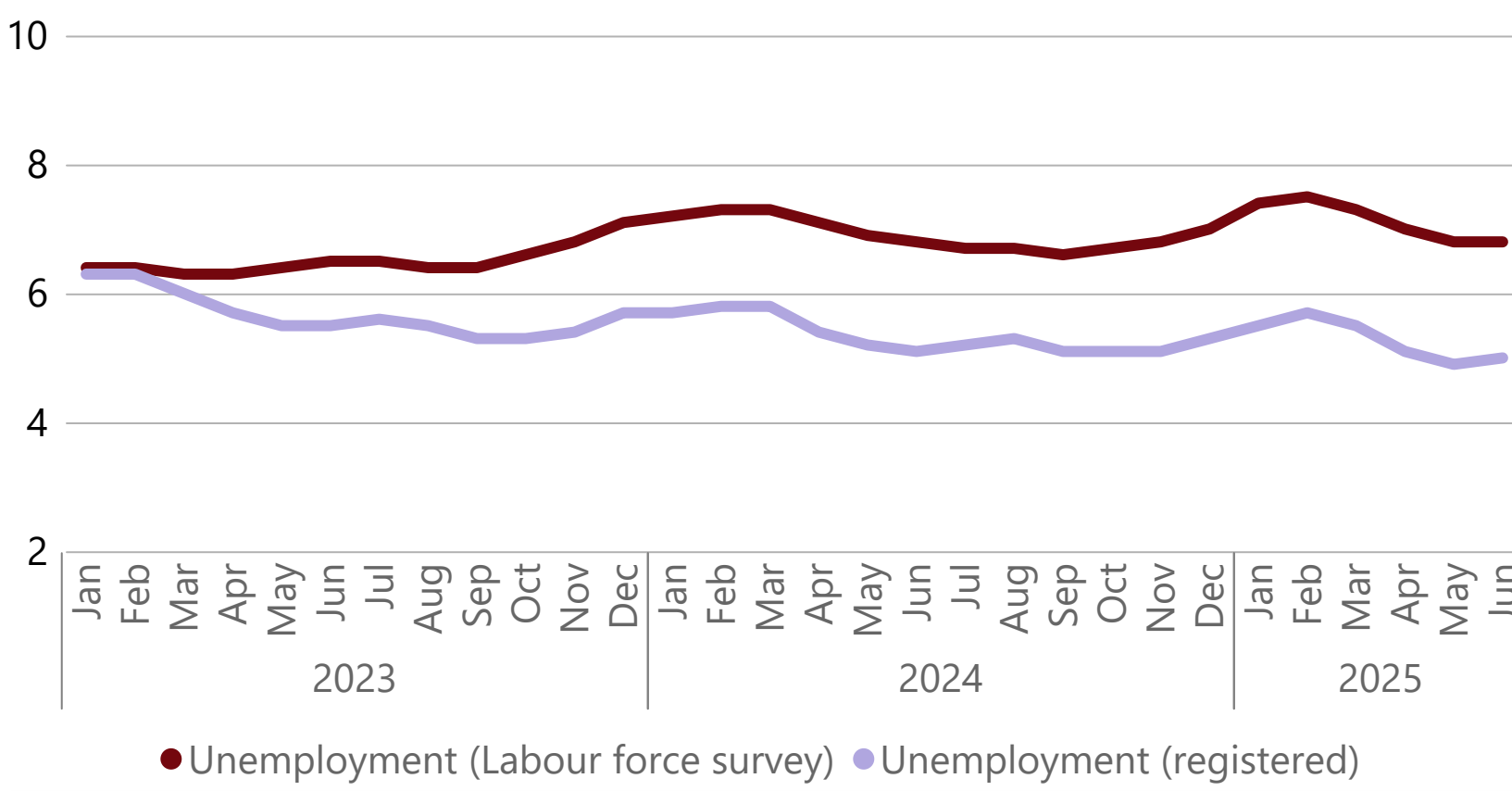

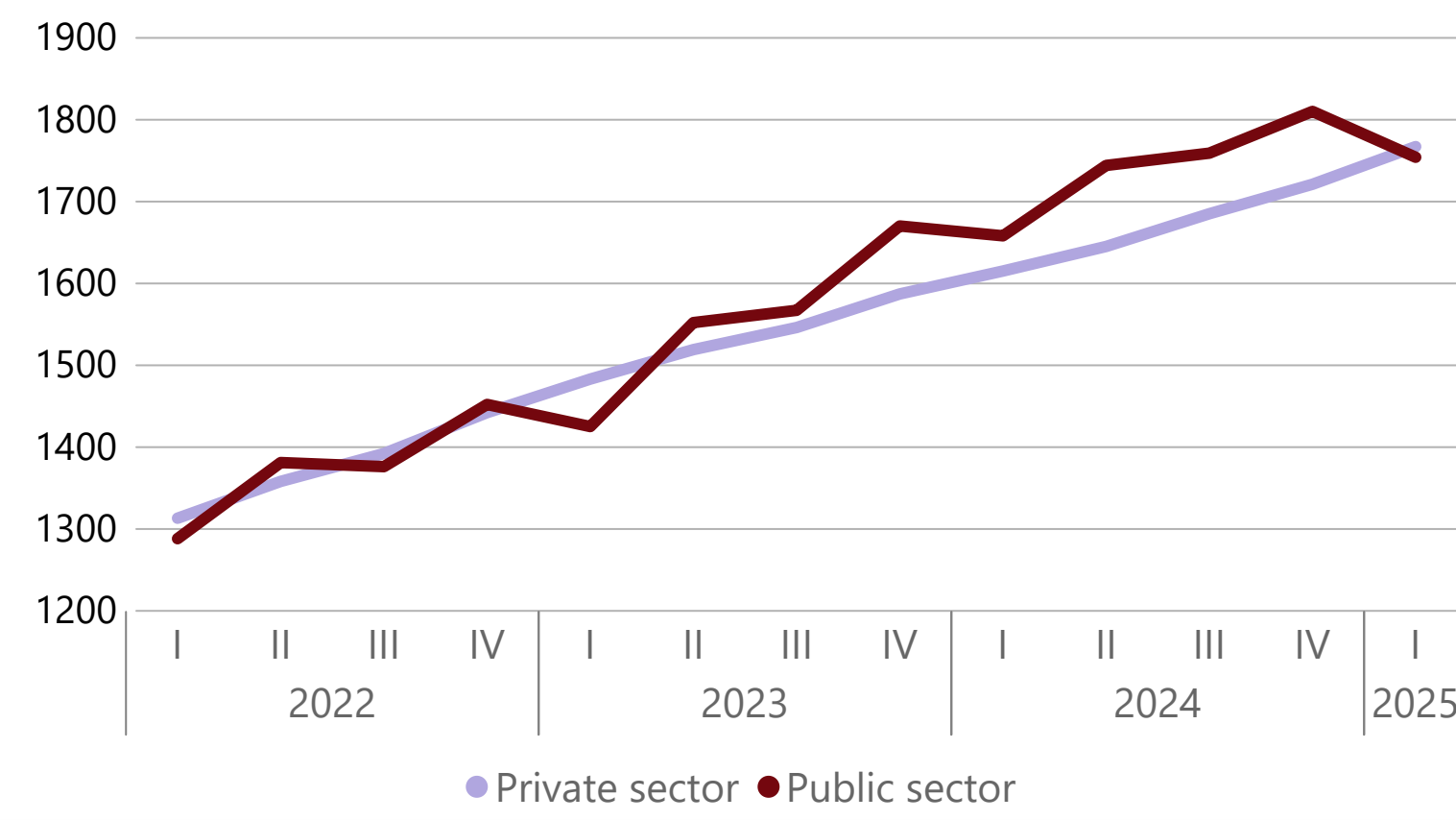

Unemployment rate, %



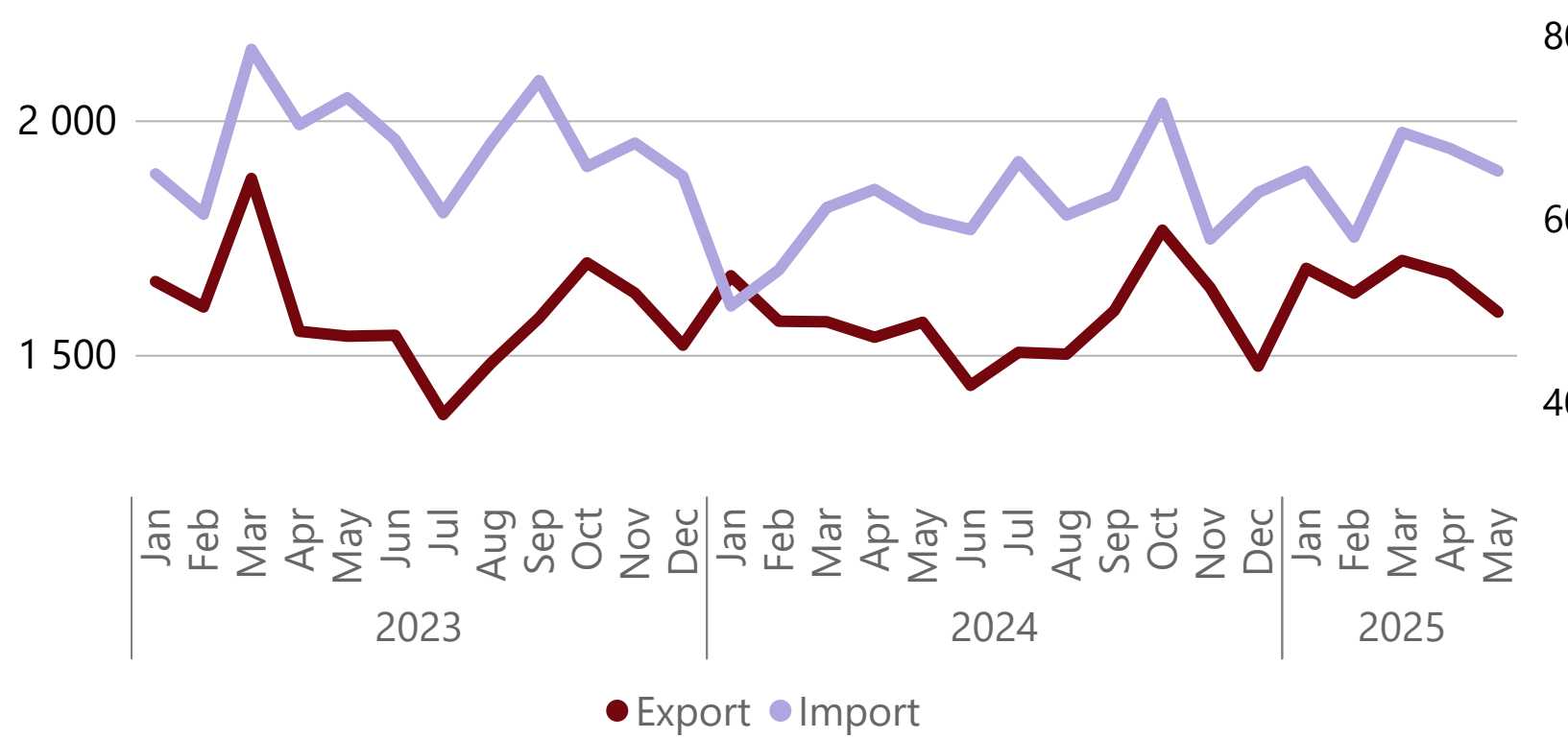

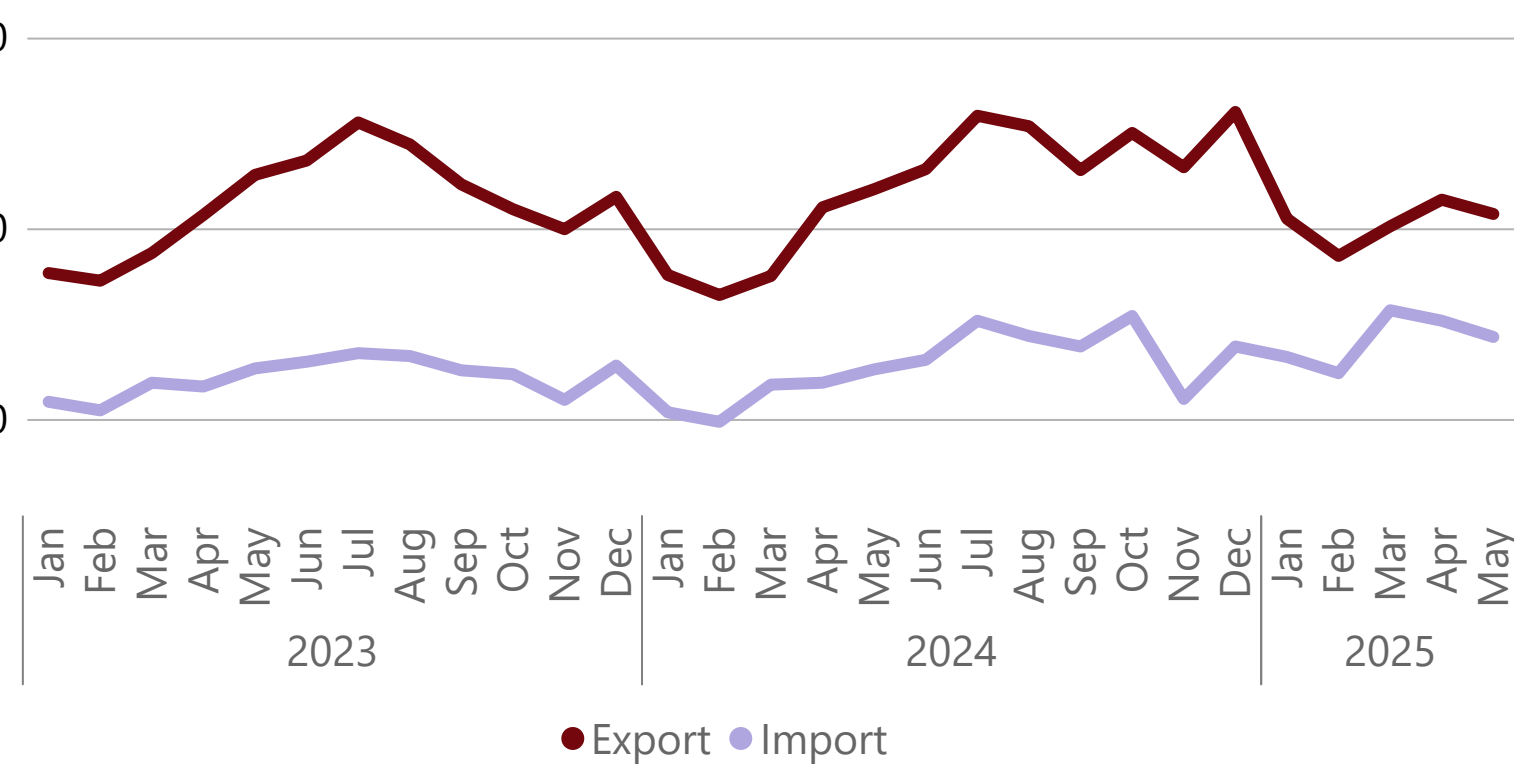

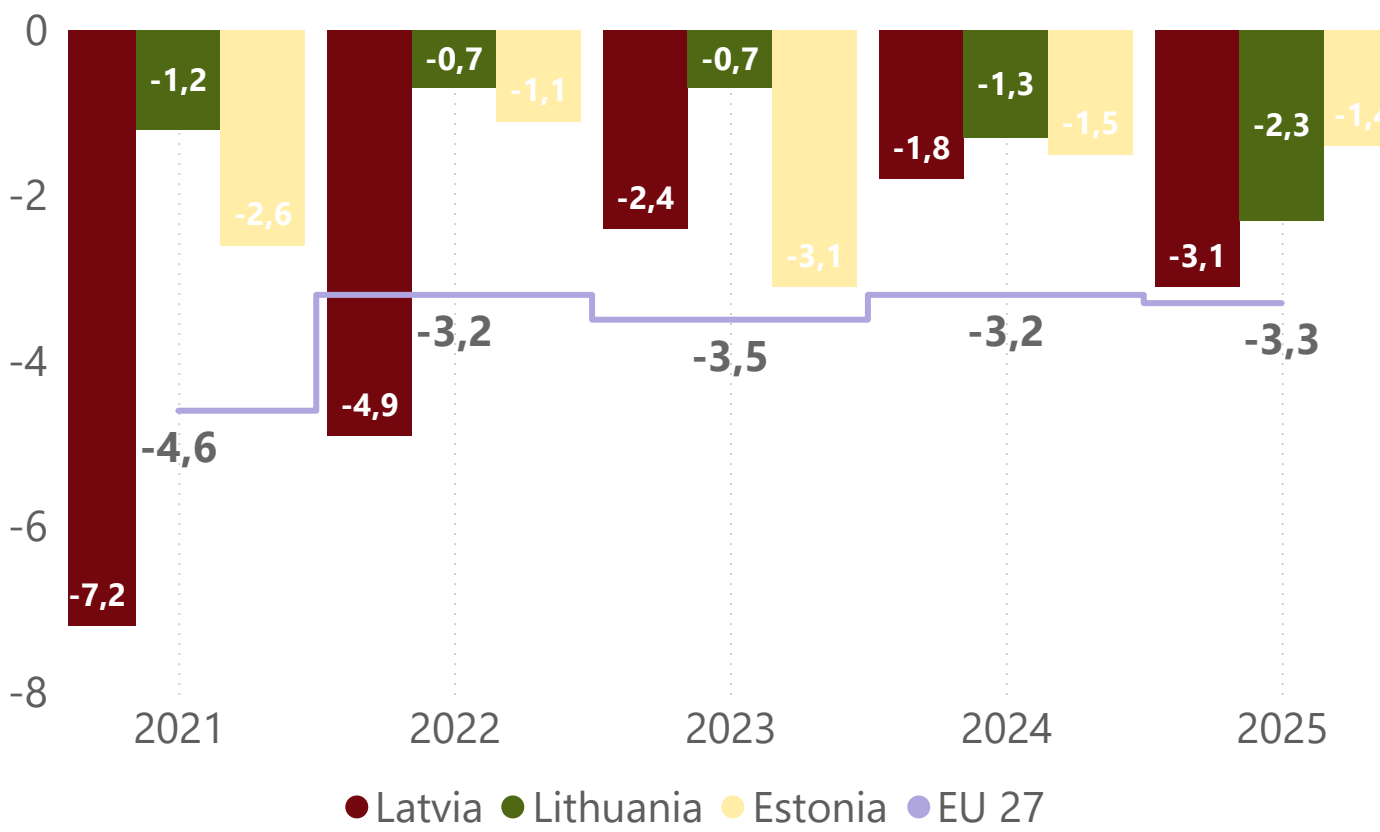

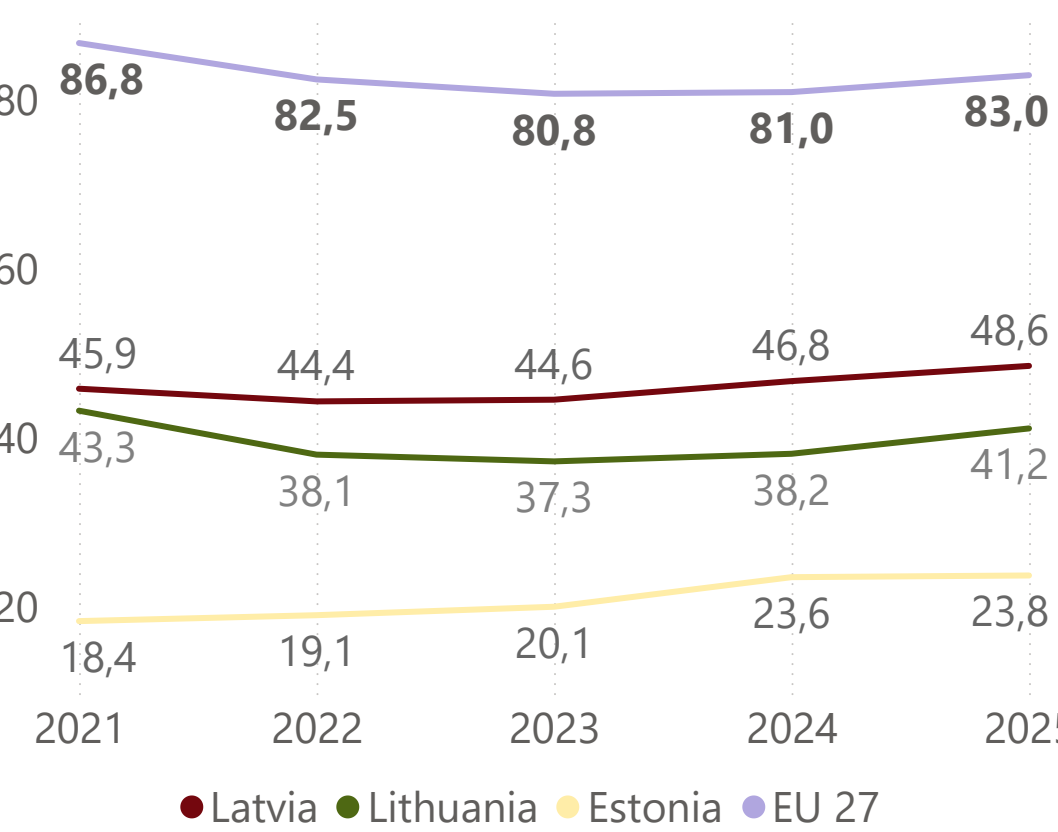

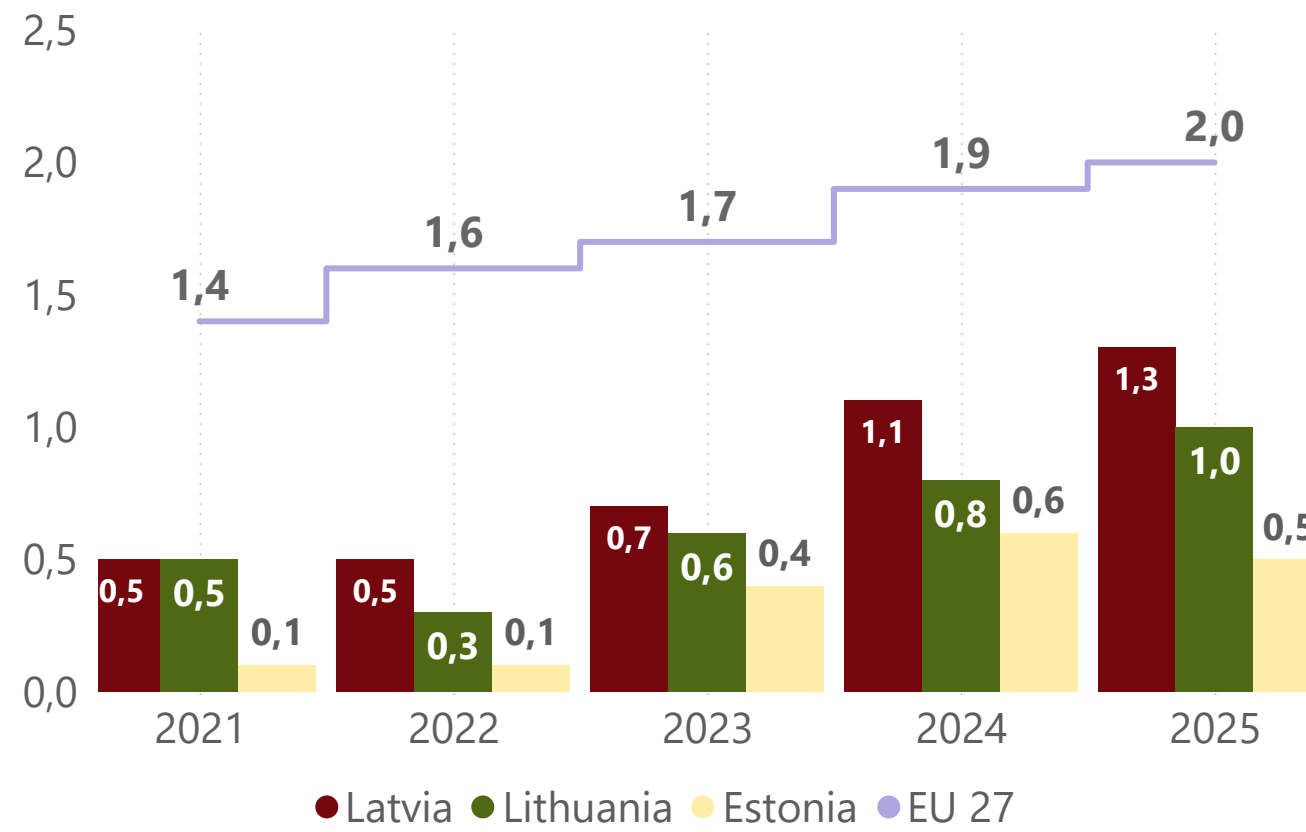
General government budget balance, % of GDP



General government debt, % of GDP



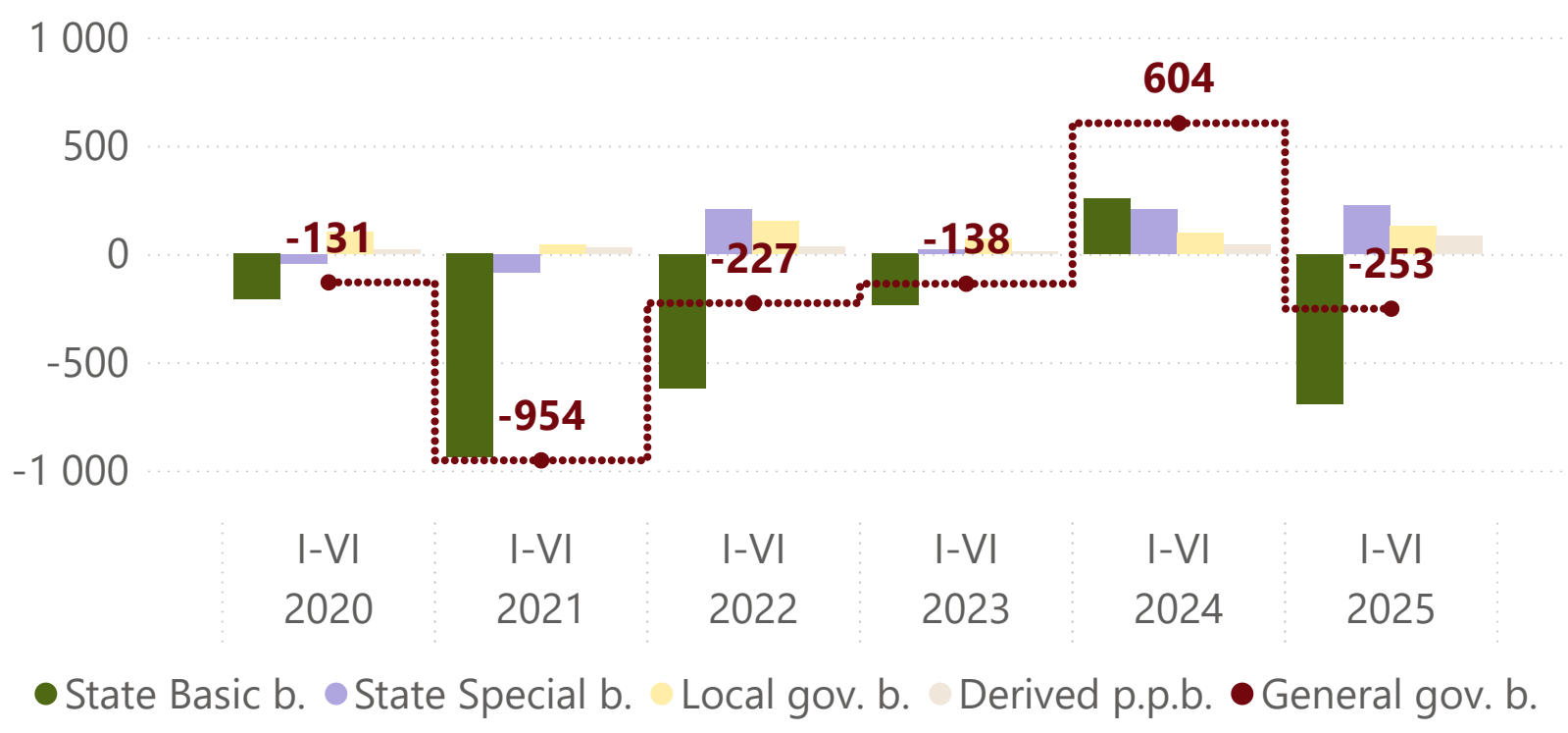
Interest expenditure (D.41), % of GDP



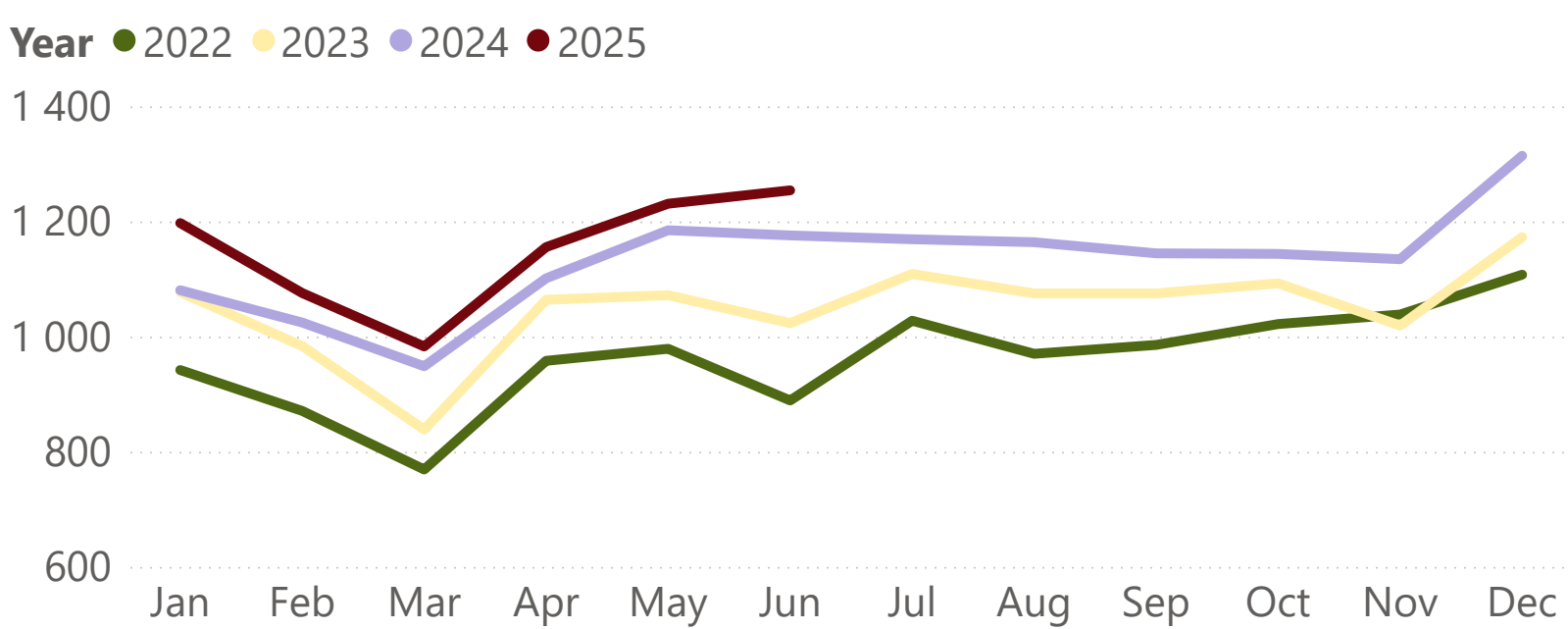

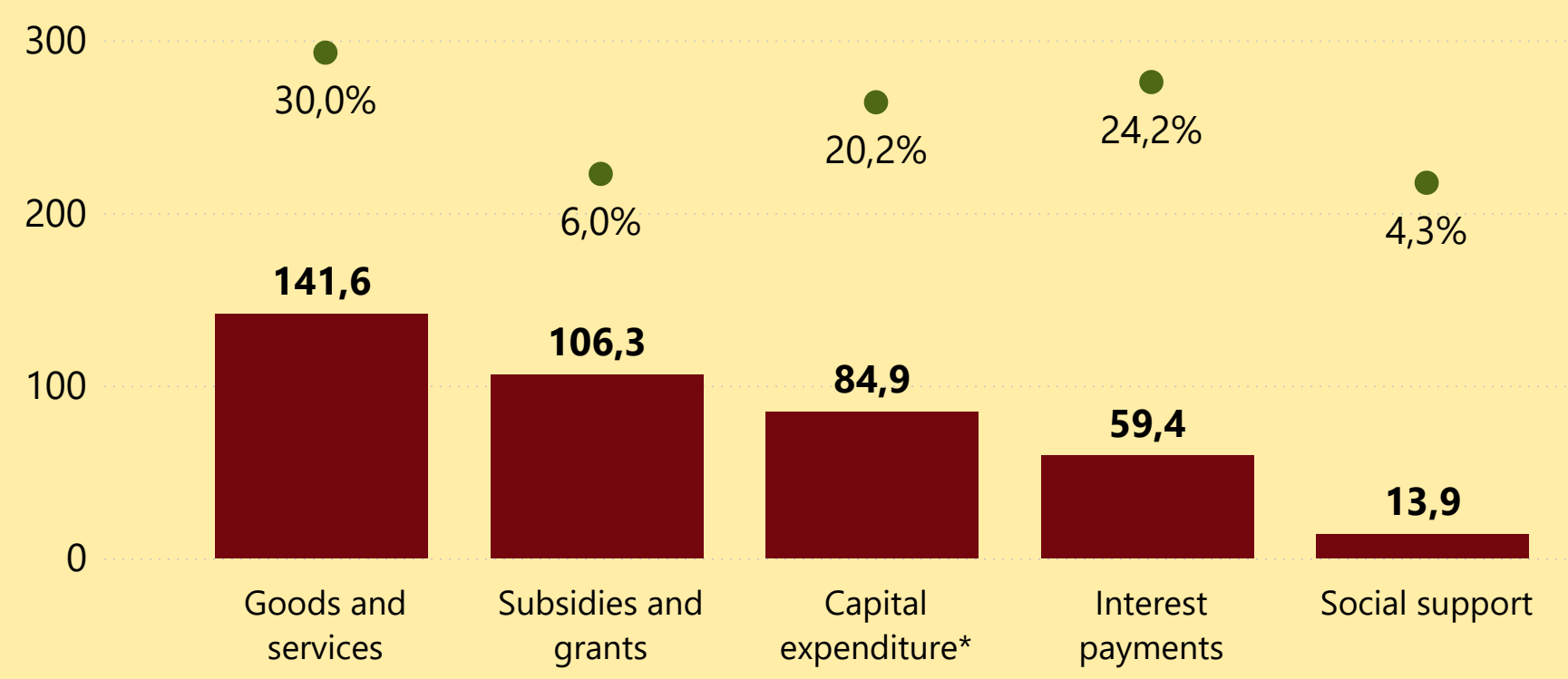

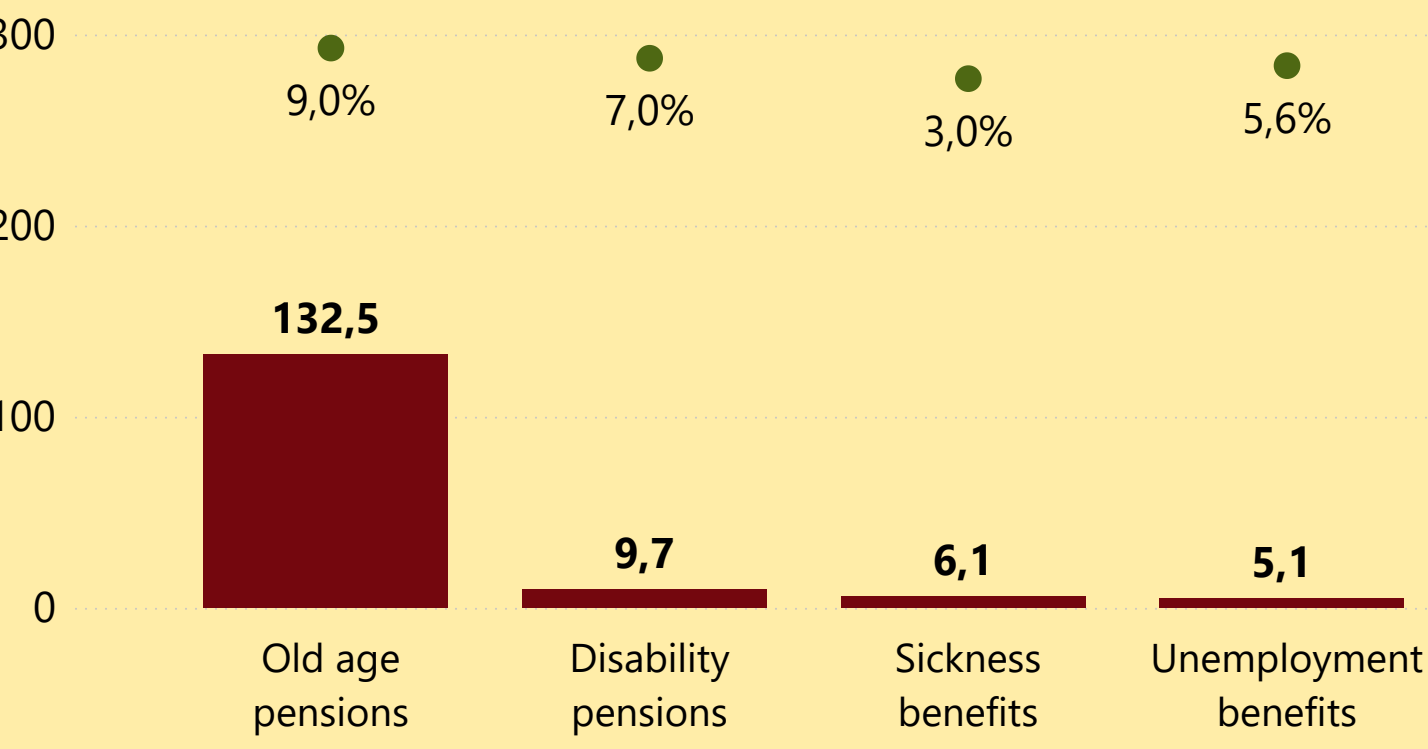

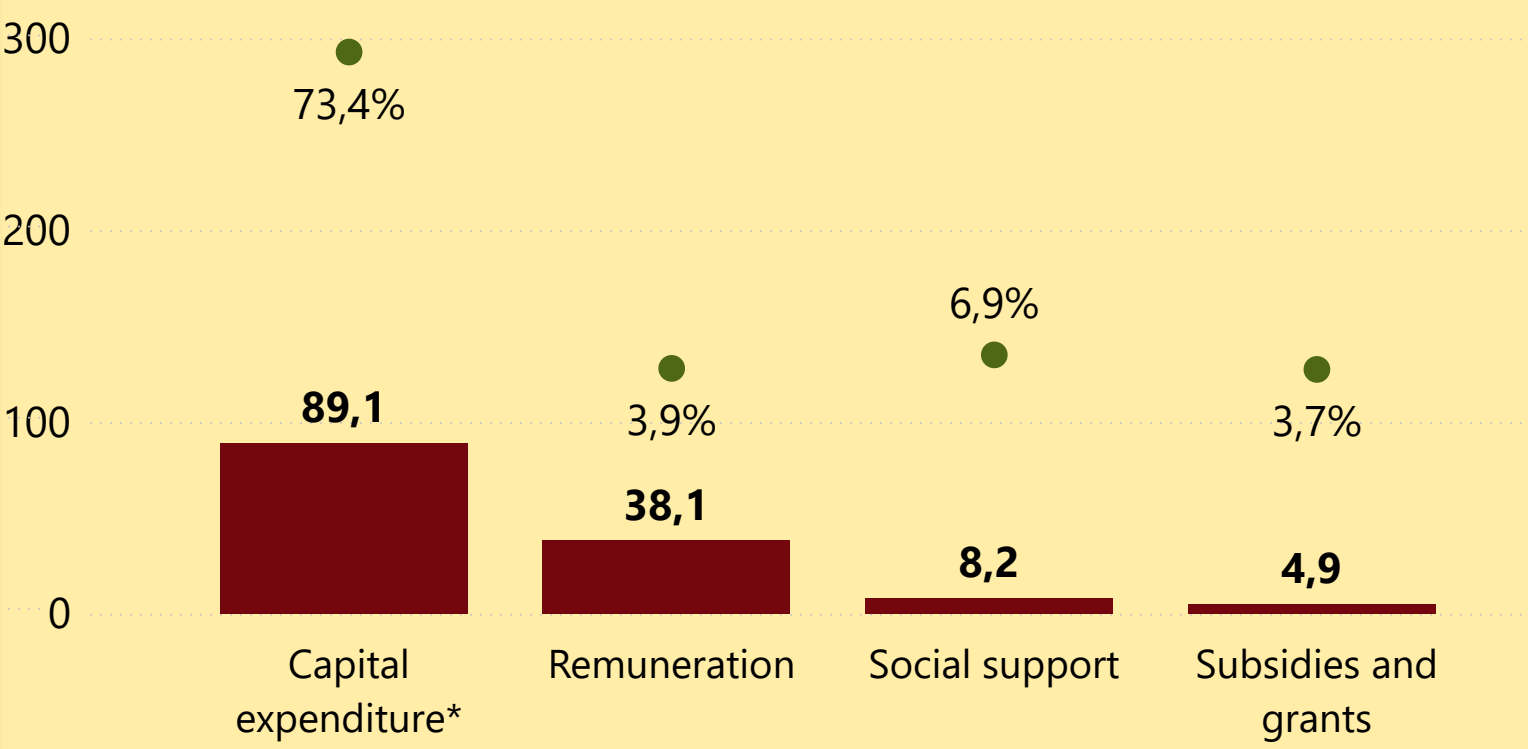

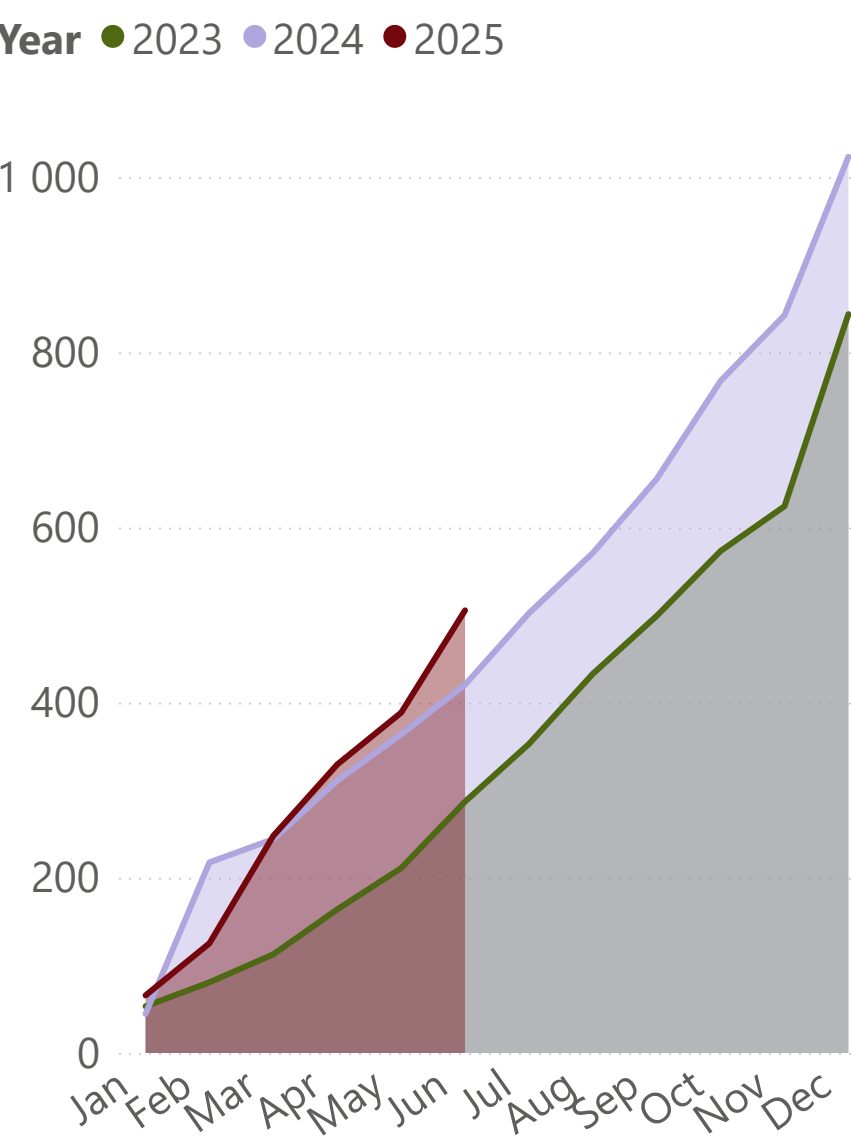

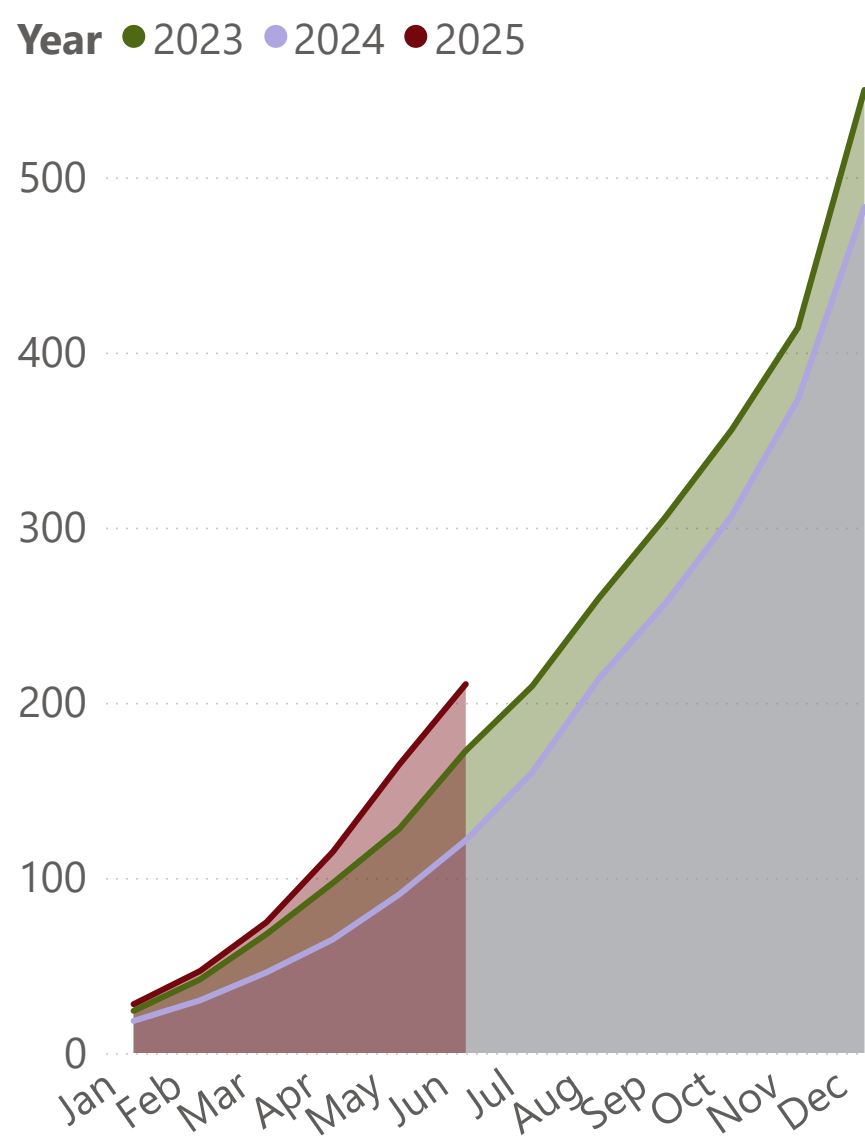


CAPITAL EXPENDITURE

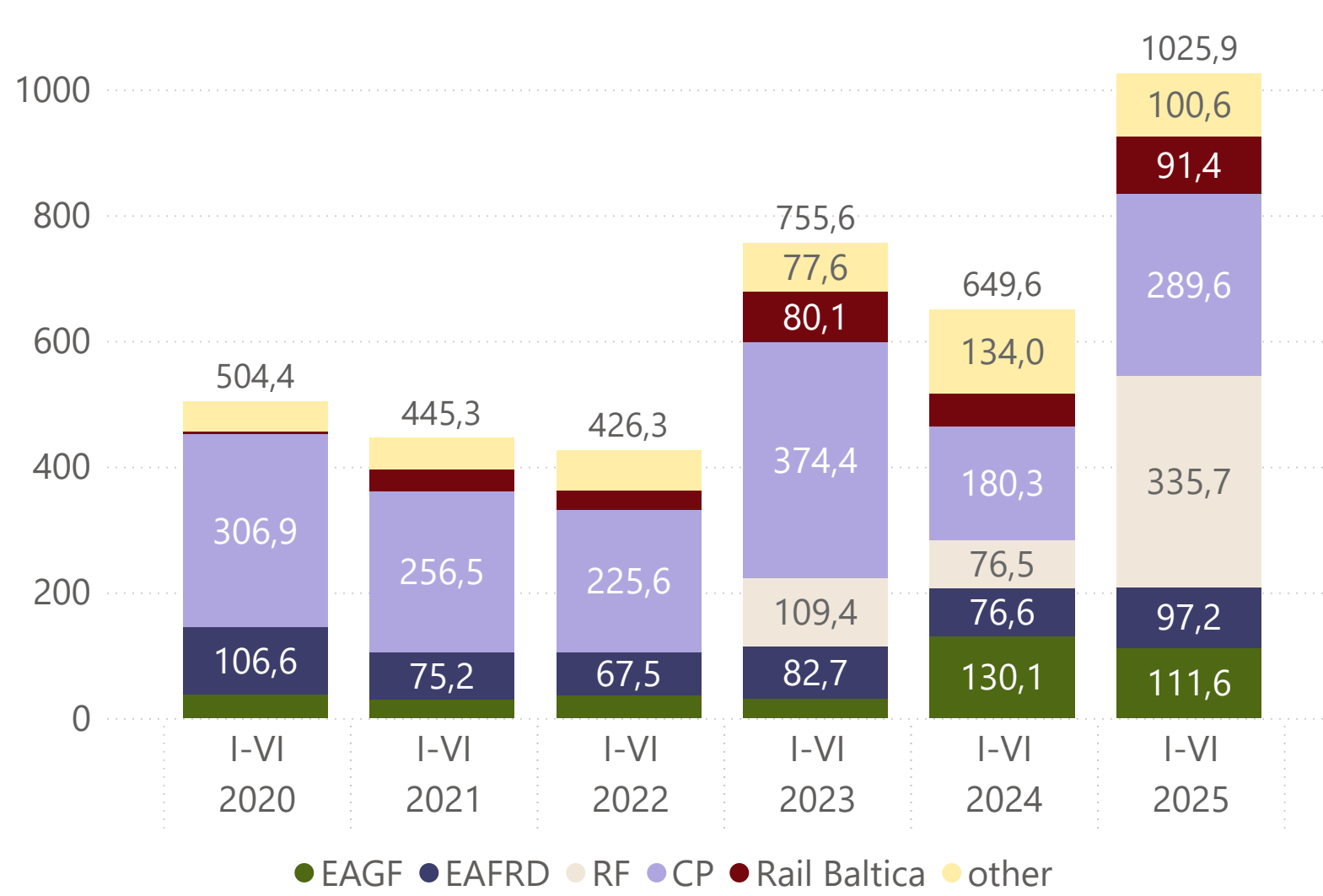
