



CEB: the social development bank for Europe




- The oldest European multilateral development institution, set up in 1956 (by 8 members of the Council of Europe)
- Exclusive social mandate
- 42 member states
- Based in Paris, France

Council of Europe Development Bank (CEB)

- 42 member states, **Ukraine accession** to be completed shortly
- Priority mission: **assistance to displaced persons**
 - €1.3 billion in loans approved in 2022 to meet needs of Ukrainian refugees in CEB member states

CEB Strategic Framework 2023-2027

CEB will remain focused on its mission and pursue three overarching goals:

- Respond to evolving social development and inclusion challenges in a flexible manner
- Invest in the assistance to and integration of refugees and migrants, in their host communities, and in preparedness for future migratory dynamics
- Support the reconstruction and rehabilitation needs of Ukraine's social sectors.

Potential engagement un Ukraine

- Direct lending support to the Government, in line with country's priorities
- Grant support for most vulnerable; grant management activities
- Technical assistance for preparation and implementation of projects
- Main sectors: health, education, housing. First project under preparation
- Coordination and partnerships with other IFIs and EU.
